


How to check your Google Classroom

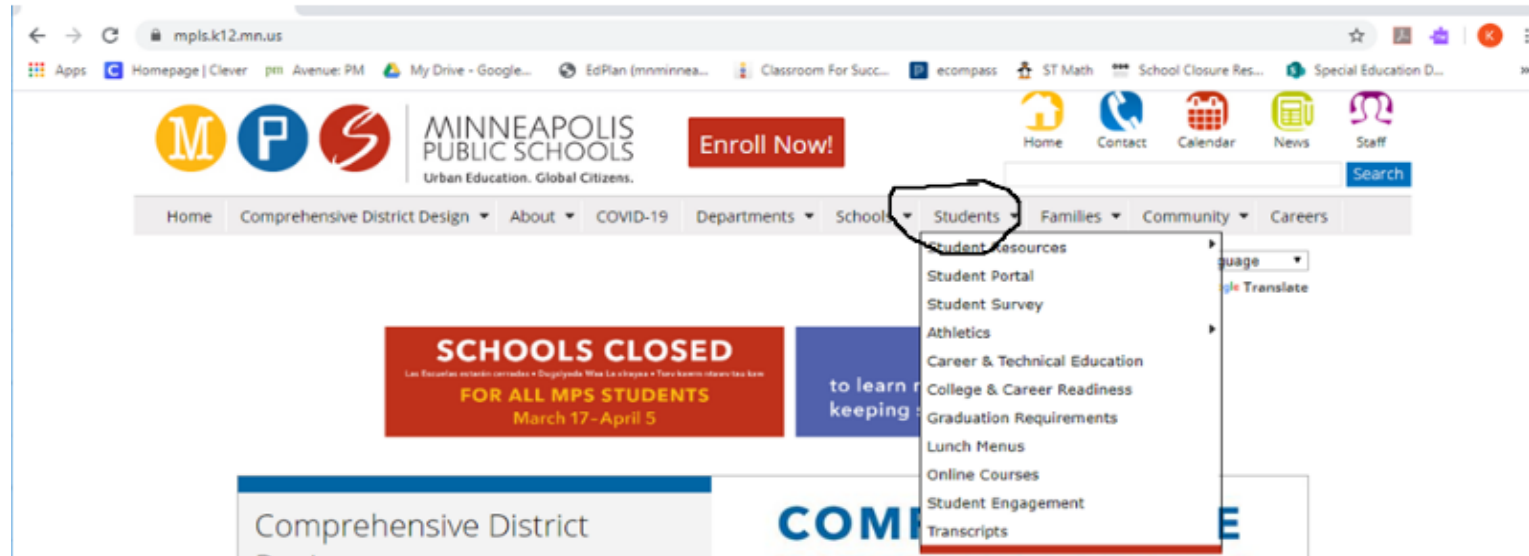




